As extremely heavy rainfall is expected, it is advised to take immediate actions on the standing crops.

- Avoid intercultural operation and application of plant protection measures and fertilizers to the standing crops. Provide adequate drainage in standing crop fields as well as nursery of aman paddy.
- Further agricultural operation may be started after the recede of excess water from the crop fields.
